RE: FY24 Older People & Persons with Disabilities (O&D) Financial Update

## Summary:

- Grant balance as of October is above benchmark by 230 basis points (2.3%).

- Local partner spending as of October is below benchmark by 410 basis points (4.1%).
- The actual vs. billed transit rate reflects a significant variance through October, roughly 28%; rebilling may be necessary.
- If rebilling is needed this will decrease available federal funds and local.
- Both Chittenden and Washington County are over benchmark in their federal grant spending.
- GMT will likely be requesting additional O&D funds during the mid-year amendment process with VTRANS.
